**Business Plan** – Edward Trewhella introduced the draft Business Plan to the Steering Group which he and Lisa Deacon had produced and focused on the main thrust of the document which is to encourage ShopMobility members to take responsibility for not only what the organisation generates in the way of benefits, but also in terms of managing its activities. To this end, now that the transition from BHTA is complete, the proposal is to form a single Board of Management to be chaired by Ann Frye, supported by Edward Trewhella and Lisa Deacon but with the Board Members being drawn from the member schemes. This would replace the current 2-tier arrangement with Driving Mobility Board members as one group and ShopMobility members as an advisory group. It was also suggested that at least one ShopMobility member join the main DrivingMobility Board in the course of next year. This was all agreed and all the scheme managers present agreed to join the ShopMobility UK Management Board.

The other main points within the Business Plan were to seek continuation funding, to attract more members and to set up and seek funding for some demonstration new ShopMobility projects.
